Points in favor of Measure F

1. Reduce healthcare costs
2. 56% more revenue per day than other hospitals
3. Higher because of the dense amount of clinics and hospitals
4. Market consolidation causes higher profits
5. Stanford operating margins – 300 millions
6. More affordable healthcare
7. Safer staffing care

Duane Dauner speaking against Measure F

Points against Measure F

1. Unfunded mandate on the City of Palo Alto
2. Palo Alto must monitor payments made to all doctors
3. The over amount received must be paid to providers and insurance Companies, some located out of state
4. The city will have to set up a unfunded program to operate this
5. Millions will have to be paid by the tax payers and the general fund to Help fund this program
